Dear Friends,

The Ageless Wisdom has long taught that the entire system of the universe—visible and invisible—is the scene of a great scheme of evolution in which life moves toward an ever more unified consciousness, responsible awareness and enlightened or spiritualized form.

This Wisdom indicates that One Life, also referred to as Pure Being, Universal Intelligence, the divine Architect, or God pervades and sustains all there is. “Having pervaded this whole universe with a fragment of Myself, I remain,” proclaims Sri Krishna in the Bhagavad Gita.

This great Intelligence, *immanent* within the human heart and within every atom of substance and also *transcendent*, apart from all expression and manifestation, is the basis of all the laws of nature and is the moving force behind all evolution.

From humanity’s perspective, the great triplicate of *desire*, *aspiration* and *direction* (will) characterize the evolutionary thrust or progress of the personal self, the Soul and the Spirit or Life manifesting through the self. What is referred to as the Plan of Light, Love and Power is as much of the sensed will of that Universal All, as the individual can grasp or understand at any particular stage in his/her experience. It encompasses the highest Good, Beauty and Truth that can be imagined at any point in time.

Thus, when the first glimmer of the Plan dawns upon the consciousness, there also comes the realization of the unity of all beings and a synthetic understanding of the evolutionary thrust. All life and all forms are seen in their true state of interrelatedness and as a result, constructive effort on behalf of all life becomes inevitable.

The objective of the Plan for our current time is to reproduce upon the plane of earth the inner kingdom of the Soul. This is the next evolutionary unfolding in the consciousness of humanity. The nature of the Soul can be described as both love-wisdom and the will-to-good.

Thus the Plan calls forth the development of an international consciousness based, not on power politics or imperialistic intentions, but an international consciousness that recognizes the “Brotherhood of Nations”—a brotherhood based on mutual need, understanding and helpfulness. Such a brotherhood realizes that the resources of the entire planet must be shared. It accepts the fact that the products of the earth, the gifts of the soil and the cultural heritage of the nations belong to the whole of humanity and not exclusively to any one nation or people.

As is indicated in the above keynote quotes, such awareness is dawning within the United Nations and is palpable within recent activities.

At the writing of this newsletter, civil society representatives had wrapped up a three-day Conference, held in Melbourne, Australia from 30 August to 1 September with an urgent call to action, stressing that achieving the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs), which world leaders have pledged to do by 2015, “is a moral imperative.”

Under the organizational sponsorship of the UN Department of Public Information, 1600 participants representing over 350 Non-Governmental Organizations from more than 70 countries adopted a wide-ranging Declaration calling on all governments, agencies, corporations and individuals to deliver on their human rights obligations to more than a billion people living in poverty. Hailed as “torch-bearers” by Kiyoo Akasaka, the Under-Secretary General for Communications and Public Information, the participants recognized the urgent need to quicken the pace of progress in order to meet the needs of the poorest and least politically powerful people on our planet.

The Declaration will be transmitted to the 140 Government leaders expected to participate in the High Level Plenary Meeting of the General Assembly from 20-22 September, just prior to the General Debate. The lofty expectations for this gathering are reflected in the following statement issued by Secretary-General, Ban Ki-Moon:

Our world possesses the knowledge and the resources to achieve the MDGs. Our challenge today is to agree on an action agenda to achieve the MDGs.

Most appropriately, the theme for the General Debate, which will follow the High Level Plenary Meeting, will be “Reaffirming the central role of the United Nations in global governance,” as proposed by President Deiss.

We could not conclude this month’s newsletter without reference to the accelerating energy behind the [UN International Day of Peace](#), observed each year on 21 September. This year, as in the past, the [International Day of Peace Vigil](#) encourages worldwide, “24-hour spiritual observations for peace and nonviolence...in every house of worship and place of spiritual practice, by all religious and spiritually based groups and individuals, and by all men, women and children who seek peace in the world.” As part of this Vigil, many around the world are filling out the [Vigil Sign Up Form](#) and committing to sounding the Great Invocation at 15 minute intervals throughout the day. Additional world-wide activities are reported in the [Pathways to Peace Website](#).

It is most interesting and especially auspicious that the above activities are occurring directly under the influence of the Libra Solar Festival or within the radius of its influence.

Libra, the esoteric wisdom tells us, is a “sign of balancing, of careful weighing of values and of achieving the right equilibrium between the pairs of opposites.” ([Esoteric Astrology](#))

As a Cardinal sign, Libra rules humanity’s subjective and spiritual life. The energies of this sign can bring the Soul, the inner spiritual reality to the foreground of consciousness, resulting in recognition of God Immanent.

Under the influence of its governing planets, Libra provides an opportunity in which a choice and a determination are inevitable.

The imperative need for right choice at this juncture in our planet’s history could not be more pronounced or clear.

Will we, in the words of President Deiss, choose rivalry and purely national interests, or work together to find constructive solutions for the dignity, security and well-being of all?

Will we choose selfish desire, or work in alignment and cooperation with the Plan of Light, Love and Power?

As spiritual workers, we have the opportunity to tip the Scales in the direction of a strengthened, revitalized United Nations and therefore, a healthy and vibrant world community—a community which recognizes that its strength is measured by the well-being of all, including and especially, the weakest of its members.

Will you add your lighted thoughts and participate in this global meditation to energize “The Spiritual Work of the United Nations and the Liberation of Humanity,” invoking on behalf of the UN, the planet and humanity, the spiritual energies of Light, Love and Power?

Due to the security concerns resulting from the high level meetings at the United Nations, the UN will be closed to visitors from Monday, September 20th until Tuesday, October 5th. Thus, all who live within the vicinity of the United Nations are invited to meet for meditation and discussion in the meditation hall, next to the Quest Book Shop at 240 E. 53rd Street (between 2nd and 3rd Avenue) from Noon – 1:15 p.m. on Wednesday, September 22nd—the day before this first of the two Libra Solar Festivals, which this month falls at exactly 5:17 a.m. U.S. EDST on September 23—the day of the opening of the General Assembly General Debate.

Those of us who live outside the New York City area have the opportunity to contribute our good energies and thoughts, using the above meditation outline not only this coming Wednesday, but weekly, every Friday.
